Agenda Item: Discussion of Decennial Committee Information Survey Results and Final Report

Highway Commissioner Beauvais presented the Maine Township’s Community Survey Results to members of the public and the Board. He stated that the Survey was available at both Maine Township and Highway Department locations, as well as on the Maine Township website, and at the information table at Maine Township Events. Highway Commissioner Beauvais said that his Department Staff also distributed surveys to residents in unincorporated Maine Township and Decennial Committee Members were also given surveys and asked to distribute and encourage residents to participate in the survey. Highway Commissioner Beauvais stated that the survey consisted of six questions. and briefly discussed the results

Highway Commissioner Beauvais summarized the results:

1. 58% of completed surveys listed improving Flood Mitigation as the highest priority of the Road District;
2. Two top items listed as the most difficult to recycle: batteries and paint;
3. The majority of surveys received were in favor of utilizing public funds to host recycling events;
4. 63% of completed surveys would like to have access to a Government Services Contact Information List;
5. 43% of completed surveys would like to have a Government Services Contact Information List available electronically, 15% preferred the list be available as a hard copy, 1% would prefer information be available both electronically and as a hard copy;
6. Those surveys that we received which that had comments or concerns were followed up on by

administrative staff. If in Highway jurisdiction, work orders were generated to have an inspection conducted, and if legitimate: items will be prioritized and completed as resources and our budget allows.

Highway Commissioner Beauvais handed out a copy of the Township Road District Report for the Board's review and stated that the final version will be presented at the last Decennial Committee Meeting.

Highway Commissioner Beauvais extended his appreciation to all Maine Township residents who took time out of their day to complete Decennial Committee Survey.
