Trustee Maher stated that the salary study from 2019, ordered by the prior Board clearly showed that 60% of the Maine Township's employees are underpaid.

Trustee Jones explained that even the 2019 Salaries Survey requested by the prior Board proved that Maine Township's employees are underpaid. The Board was adamant and discarded the whole survey.

The Board officials agreed that a new salary survey should be done.

Supervisor Dimond stated that the Board could find the PACE's Municipal Vehicle Program Agreement at their place. She said that the rental of an accessible van will help Maine Townships' seniors and disabled persons be brought to doctor's appointments, grocery stores, etc. Supervisor Dimond invited the Board members to a meeting with a PACE representative on March 11th, at 11:00 a.m.

Clerk Gialamas stated that Cook County will send an email in March to submit the Statement of Economic Interest with the deadline to file on May 1st. Clerk Gialamas reminded everyone about the Annual Town Meeting that is scheduled for April 9th.
