**DAY 1** Aloha! Arrive in Honolulu with a lei greeting. This city of sunsets, rainbows and tropical flowers sits like a gem between ancient volcanoes and the deep blue sea. Sheraton Waikiki Beach for 3 nights. Dinner at hotel.

**DAY 2** Breakfast. Visit historic Pearl Harbor and Arizona Memorial. Guided tour of Honolulu. Highlights include: Hawaiian State Capitol, Iolani Palace, Kawaiahaeo Church, King Kamehameha Statue & the Punchbowl National Cemetery of the Pacific. Free afternoon to enjoy Waikiki Beach. 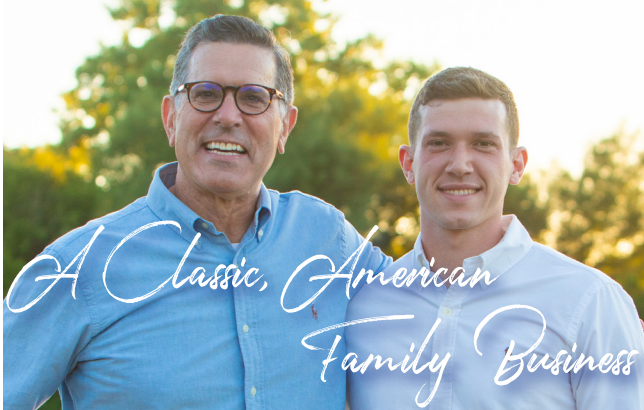
