YOUR ITINERARY

DAY 1 FLIGHT TO BARCELONA, SPAIN.

DAY 2 BARCELONA Arrive at hotel in Barcelona. Evening at leisure.

DAY 3 BARCELONA – EMBARKATION Explore Barcelona’s iconic sites: Columbus Monument, Port Vell, Arc de Triomf, and Olympic Port, built for 1992 Olympic Games before embarking on your ship. (B, D)

DAY 4 BARCELONA Discover Las Ramblas, the mile-long leafy pedestrian boulevard. Stroll the Gothic Quarter, where ancient and modern sit side by side. See Passeig de Gràcia, renowned for its architecture including works by Antoni Gaudí. (B, L, D)

DAY 5 MARSEILLE, FRANCE Marseille is France’s oldest city. Discover its atmospheric Old Port, overseen by two 17th-century fortresses. Take in Notre Dame de la Garde, Palais Longchamp, and Aix-en-Provence. (B, L, D)

DAY 6 MONTE CARLO, MONACO Monaco — playground for the rich and famous and gateway to the South of France. Visit medieval Monaco: Prince’s Palace and St. Nicholas Cathedral, the burial site of the royal family. See Casino de Monte-Carlo, the most prestigious and celebrated gambling mecca on Earth. (B, L, D)

DAY 7 FLORENCE/PISA, ITALY Scenic drive through the Tuscan countryside to Florence. See the Basilica di Santa Maria del Fiore, medieval Ponte Vecchio and the attractive Basilica di Santa Croce, resting place of Michelangelo. In Pisa explore the Square of Miracles, including the famous Leaning Tower, Cathedral and Baptistery. (B, L, D)

DAY 8 ROME, ITALY Marvel at the magnificent Colosseum, where gladiators once battled; the historic Roman Forum, gathering place and political center of the ancients; and Vatican City. (B, L, D)

DAY 9 NAPLES, ITALY Take in magnificent examples of Greek and Roman architecture and the Piazza del Plebiscito, the grandest public square in the city, facing the former Royal Palace of the King of Naples. Take a drive along the stunning Amalfi Coast. (B, L, D)

DAY 10 CRUISE THE IONIAN SEA
Enjoy a day of relaxation at sea. (B, L, D)

DAY 11 CORFU (KÉRKYRA), GREECE
See Corfu, resplendent with charming pastel town houses and pristine white beaches. (B, L, D)

DAY 12 DUBROVNIK, CROATIA Playwright George Bernard Shaw once declared, “Those who seek paradise on earth should come to Dubrovnik.” Discover this 12th-century walled city’s historic Pile Gate, Sponza Palace, and 15th-century Onofrio’s Fountain. Explore the famed Dubrovnik Riviera with a cruise along the Lapad peninsula. (B, L, D)

DAY 13 SPLIT, CROATIA Experience the ancient Diocletian Palace and Ethnographic Museum, take a rafting trip on the Cetina River, explore Croatian hinterland to see waterfalls of Krka National Park, or discover intimate destinations along the Dalmatian Coast. (B, L, D)

DAY 14 VENICE, ITALY Visit St. Mark’s Square, Doge’s Palace and the ornate interior of St. Mark’s Basilica. Take a boat to Murano to see glassmakers at work in their centuries-old tradition. Historic island of San Giorgio Maggiore. (B, L, D)

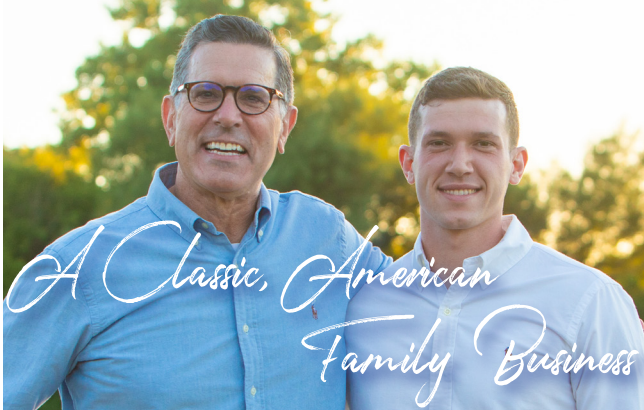
