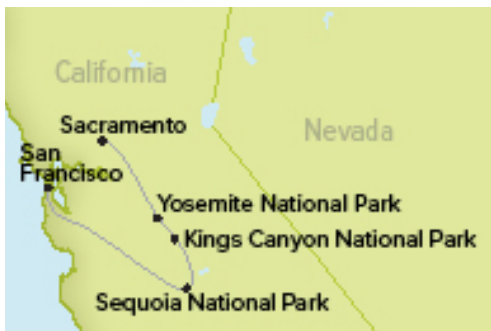

DAY 4 Breakfast. Visit Mariposa Grove of Giant Sequoias in Yosemite National Park. Box lunch. Arrive at Wuksachi Lodge in the Sequoia National Park for a 2-night stay. Dinner at lodge with a Living History Performance of stories relating to "Life Under the Big Trees."

DAY 5 Breakfast. Guided tour of Sequoia National Park with a naturalist guide featuring Giant Forest Grove & General Sherman Tree, Big Tree Trail at Round Meadow, box lunch, Kings Canyon National Park, General Grant Tree & Grant Grove Village. Return to lodge with dinner.

DAY 6 Breakfast. Lunch & tour at Hillmar Chese Factory. Arrive at the luxurious San Francisco Marriott Union Square for a 2-night stay. This hotel is a vibrant destination in San Francisco.

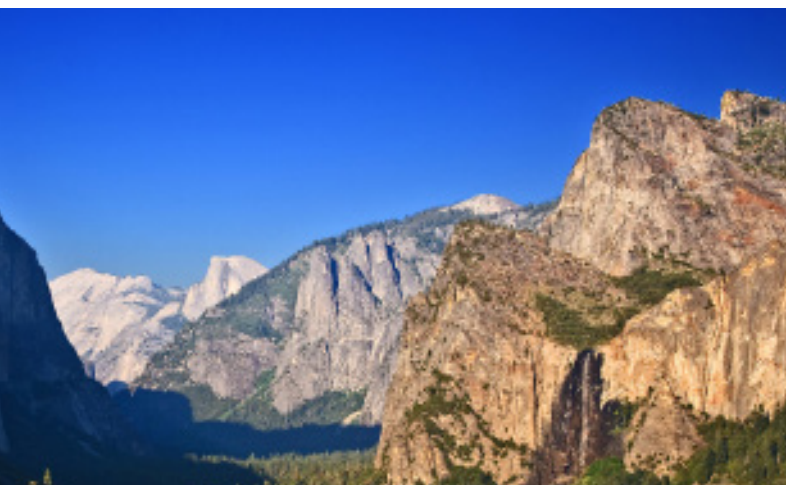
