DAY 1 Welcome to Portland, Oregon. Lodging in Vancouver, Washington. Dinner.

DAY 2 Breakfast. Guided tour of Portland "The Rose City" Tour. Board the American Empress.

DAY 3 Astoria, OR: Premium Shore Excursion: Lewis & Clark Experience.
