YOUR ITINERARY

DAY 1 Aloha! Arrive in Honolulu with a lei greeting. This city of sunsets, rainbows and tropical flowers sits like a gem between ancient volcanoes and the deep blue sea. Sheraton Waikiki Beach for 3 nights. Dinner at hotel.

DAY 2 Breakfast. Visit historic Pearl Harbor and Arizona Memorial. Picture stop at Iolani Palace & King Kamehameha Statue. Free afternoon to enjoy Waikiki Beach. Star of Honolulu Sunset Dinner Cruise featuring Polynesian entertainment and live band.

DAY 3 Breakfast. Driving Tour of Punchbowl National Cemetery of the Pacific with a stop at Dole Plantation. Enjoy views of North Shore beaches, the surfing capital of the world. Spend the afternoon and evening at Polynesian Cultural Center — seven native villages give visitors the rare chance to participate in the daily adventures of Hawaiian and other South Pacific cultures. 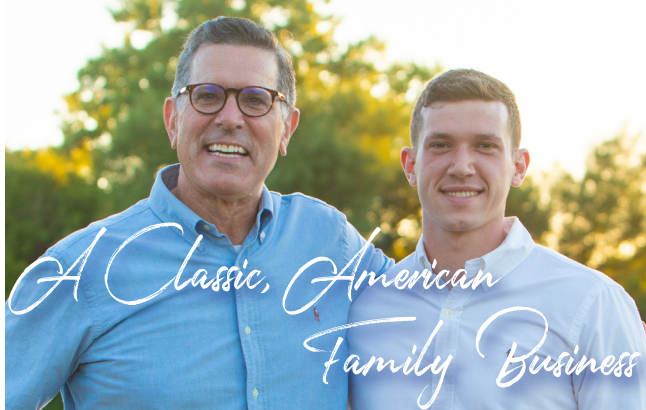
