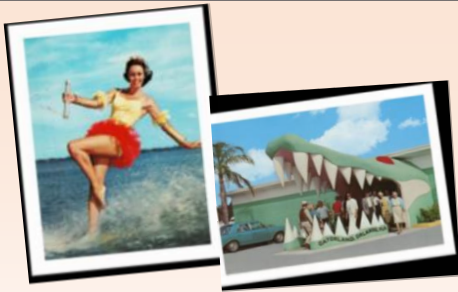

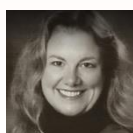

She headed up a small team of people who ultimately were able to smuggle 2,500 Jewish children from the ghetto and relocate them to orphanages and homes of non-Jewish families, saving their lives.
