

MaineStreamers Exploring Hannibal & St. Louis, Missouri

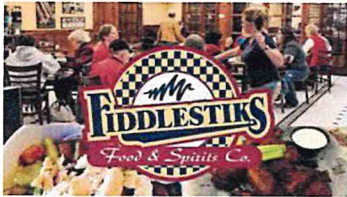
Wednesday, September 24th, to Friday, September 26th, 2025 (3 Days / 2 Nights)

Enjoy 3 days / 2 nights trip to Hannibal & St. Louis, Missouri. This trip is offered by the MaineStreamers for members and their guests only. Explore what Hannibal & St. Louis, Missouri, have to offer while creating new friendships and memorable experiences.

Day 1, Wednesday, September 24th



Arrive in Hannibal, Missouri, as you step back in time and relive the days of Mark Twain. Our first stop will be a country buffet lunch at Fiddlesticks Food & Spirits Company. After lunch we will enjoy a one-hour sightseeing cruise on the Mark Twain Riverboat with storytelling and scenic views. Then we're off to visit The Mark Twain Boyhood Home & Museum where we will discover how Samuel Clemens, a young boy growing up in this small Mississippi River town, became one of the world's most famous authors. A 45-minute tour will give you the chance to explore the Hannibal of Clemens' childhood and experience the beloved stories he created through the power of his imagination. Traverse the labyrinth which inspired Mark Twain's famous work, *The Adventures of Tom Sawyer*, an hour-long, guided tour of Missouri's oldest show cave. The Mark Twain Cave is 3/8-mile-long and a constant 52 degrees. Before heading to St. Louis, we will enjoy dinner at the Saints Avenue Steakhouse for a homemade cooked buffet.

Lastly, we will drive to St. Louis to our hotel, St. Louis Union Station Hotel, Curio Collection by Hilton for a 2-night stay. The hotel was once the busiest train station in the world. St. Louis Union Station captures the essence of history, fun and entertainment that St. Louis offers, such as the ferris wheel adjacent to the hotel, the Fire and Light Show on the lake set to themed music, a miniature golf course, and carousel. Anchoring the Union Station entertainment complex is the stunning St. Louis Aquarium. The 120,000-square-foot attraction features one-of-a-kind exhibits and tanks with 1.3 million gallons of water, housing thousands of aquatic species from the rivers and oceans of the world. You won't have to leave St. Louis Union Station to get a bite to eat either. The St. Louis Union Station Soda Fountain is a 1950's style diner featuring ice cream, candy, burgers and booze. The 1894 Café features quick bites and The Fudgery provides world-class fudge. **Lunch and Dinner Included.**



Day 2, Thursday, September 25th



Breakfast will be on your own at one of the hotels restaurants/coffee shops. We begin our day at the Gateway Arch National Park. A tram will lift you 630 feet up to the top of the tallest man-made monument in the United States. The museum at the Gateway Arch has an interactive exhibit that narrates the history of Native Americans, explorers, pioneers, and rebels who played a key role in shaping America, showcasing their stories through six distinct themed areas that highlight the nation's pioneering spirit. After touring the Gateway Arch, we will enjoy a meal at Best Chicken Hodak's Restaurant & Bar.

Then we're off to the Anheuser-Busch Brewery, the single largest brewing complex in the world. The company was built on a dream. For 165 years, Anheuser-Busch has pledged allegiance to America and its people. They take great pride as one of the country's most iconic companies and hold precious to their responsibility to brewing great-tasting, high quality beers. The tour of the brewery will include the Brewhouse, Beechwood Aging Cellars, where you will learn about secondary fermentation using beechwood chips and the brewing process, along with the famous Bevo Packing Facility, a bottling plant. Learn the history of the Clydesdales visiting the paddock and stables. We will end the tour with a refreshing beer.

Enjoy the evening at Pappy's Smokehouse. Pappy's is known for their Memphis BBQ. The legendary smokehouse's BBQ ribs, which are the house specialty, produced what The Food Network called the "Best Ribs in America." At Pappy's Smokehouse, meats are slow smoked for 24 hours over sweet apple or cherry wood. Founded by John Matthews, Mike Emerson and Skip Steele in 2008, Pappy's does indeed serve some of the best ribs in America, garnering many celebrity fans, including Jimmy Kimmel, Wendy Williams, and Hugh Jackman, and it's been featured on Travel Channel's "Man vs. Food," "The Zimmern List," and the Food Network's "Big Food Bucket List." **Lunch & Dinner Included. Day 3, Friday, September 26th



Breakfast will be on your own this morning. Choose from the hotel restaurant, the Starbucks, or visit somewhere local near the hotel. Next, we will tour a National Historic Landmark, the home of Scott Joplin, the famous ragtime composer. Then we will travel to one of St. Louis' unique neighborhoods and see the Cathedral Basilica of St. Louis, considered by many to be the greatest example of Byzantine architecture in the world. This Roman Catholic Church, is a major landmark in the city of St. Louis. You will have lunch on your own at the City Foundry STL. City Foundry STL is the adaptive reuse of the former 15-acre Century Foundry Complex in St. Louis. The iconic and historically significant foundry building has been transformed into a dynamic hub of innovation complete with St. Louis' first true food hall, a curated retail experience, and creative offices infused with historic industrial architecture. Then we're off to the Busch family home, Grant's Farm since 1903. Grant's Farm is an iconic, yet accessible destination, celebrating the family's German heritage. Grant's Farm is home to more than 100 animal species, including the famous Budweiser Clydesdales. It was once owned by the former U.S. President Ulysses S. Grant. You will have a short tram ride through Deer Park at Grant's Farm, enjoy a 75 min. tour of the World-Famous Budweiser Clydesdales. You will learn about their training processes, tour their home, meet the Clydesdale handler, and interact with your own personal Clydesdales appearance! Then we're off, back to Chicago. **Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner on your own.**
