



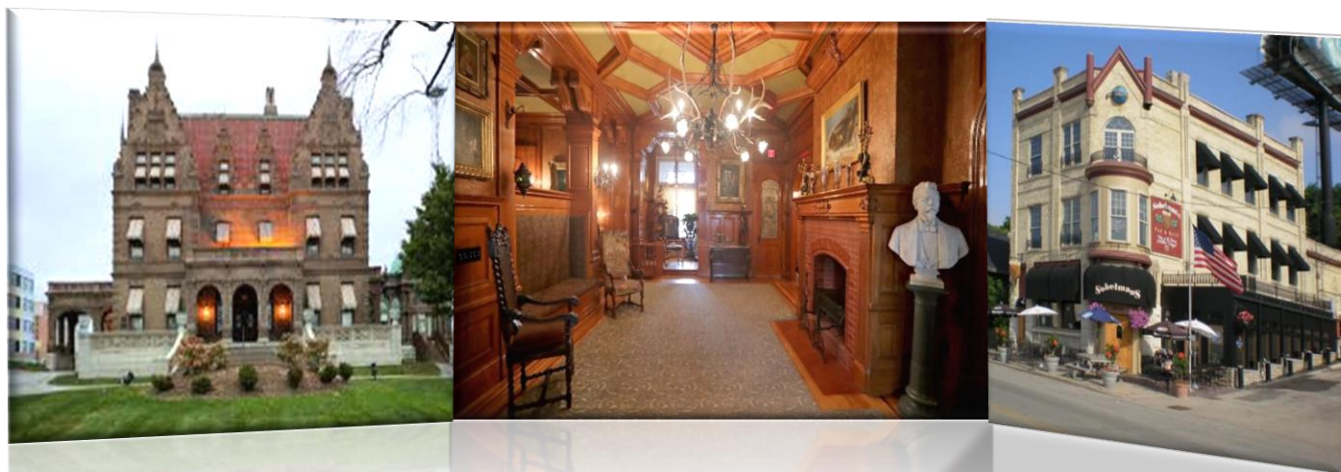

Day 1:

Let's start our day off with a stop at Pabst Mansion in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, with a self-guided tour. After lunch we will visit the Mitchell Park Domes. No matter the weather outside, the Mitchell Park Domes are always toasty warm inside, and the annual holiday show is one of Milwaukee's top winter attractions. We can expect to find a display featuring poinsettias, chrysanthemums, amaryllis, and other plants, as well as a decorated spruce. Afterwards, we will stop at The Wreath Factory in Plymouth, Wisconsin. We will get a demonstration of how they make their famous wreaths, which combine a signature blend of pine, cedar and balsam with other botanicals.



After The Wreath Factory, we travel to Elkhart Lake to the beautiful Osthoff Resort to check in. Once checked in, we will enjoy dinner at Lake Street Café. *(Lunch, Dinner included)*



Day 2:

We start our day with a breakfast buffet, followed by the Old-World Christmas Market. Stroll the aisles of a grand heated tent with fragrant boughs of fresh evergreens and the tantalizing scent of roasted almonds as you browse for unique and specialty items amongst international and regional artisans. The Old-World Food Court offers shoppers space to relax and enjoy delectable German fare, such as hot gluhwein, sauerbraten, dumplings, schnitzel, potato pancakes, red cabbage, pulled pork and apple strudel. You will enjoy lunch on your own.



After our wonderful stay at the Osthoff Resort we board our motor coach for a tour of the Siberian Outpost. While visiting with the dogs you will learn about sledding, the history of the Iditarod, and the training of one of winter's most interesting sports. We will get up close and personal with the dogs to understand the amount of manpower required to keep the operation running. We will have a quick stop at the Cedar Valley Cheese Store.



Our last stop will be at Roden Barnyard Adventures. Listen to the sleigh bells ring while a team of percheron horses pull us across beautiful wooded acres, following the thousands of lights that light the way.
