DAY 1 FLIGHT TO BUDAPEST, HUNGARY.

DAY 2 BUDAPEST Arrive at hotel in Budapest for 2-night stay. Evening at leisure.

DAY 3 BUDAPEST Budapest, “Queen of the Danube,” is one of Europe’s most regal and storied cities with most of its iconic sights just off the banks of the Danube. (B)

DAY 4 BUDAPEST – EMBARKATION Embark ship to begin your Melodies of the Danube Cruise. (B, D)

DAY 5 BUDAPEST Guided tour of Budapest features the Great Market Hall, Heroes’ Square, Castle Hill, Fisherman’s Bastion, Matthias Church as well as both the Buda (hilly) and the Pest (flat) sides of the river. (B, L, D)

DAY 6 BRATISLAVA, SLOVAKIA Host to the crowning ceremonies of 11 Hungarian kings and queens between 1536 and 1830, Bratislava certainly has earned the title “Coronation City of Kings.” Join a special “Tastes of Slovakia” tour. (B, L, D)

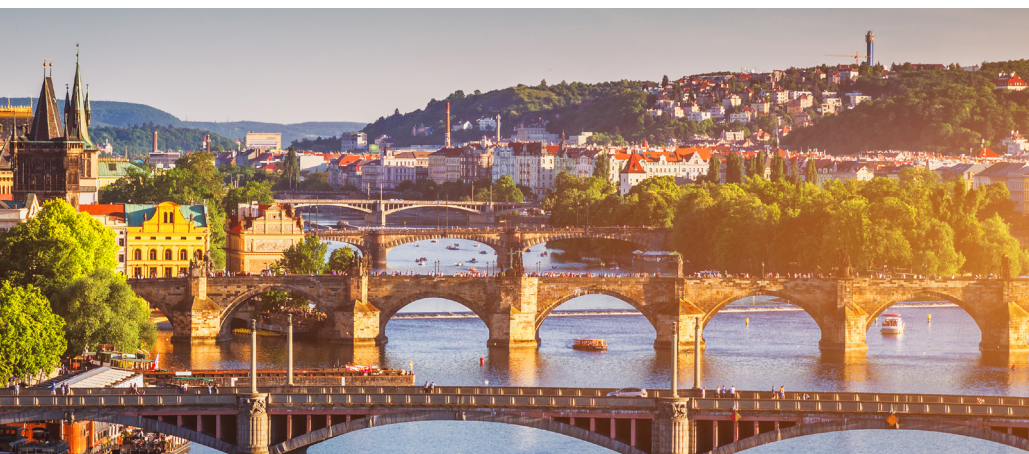

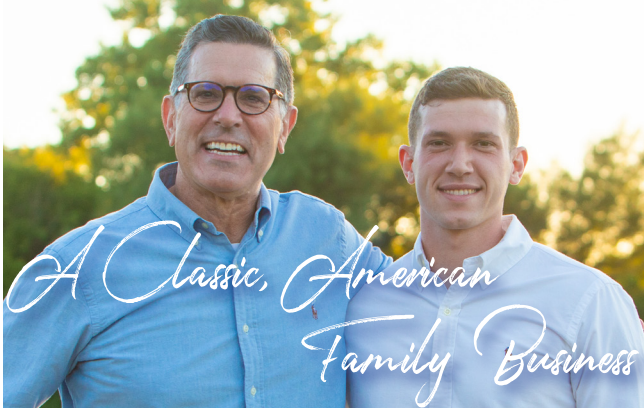
