YOUR ITINERARY

DAY 1 Flight to Calgary. Arrive at Fairmont Palliser Hotel for a 1-night stay. Set in the heart of the city, Fairmont Palliser is an historical landmark offering elegant accommodations. Dinner.

DAY 2 Breakfast. Journey into Banff National Park. See Banff's unique Hoodoo Rock formations, Surprise Corner, and Tunnel Mountain Drive. Climb to the top of Sulphur Mountain on the Banff Gondola. Savor 360-degree views of Banff's beautiful mountains. Arrive at the Banff Moose Hotel for a 2-night stay. Dinner.
