## **How Can Maine Township Assist You?**

<u>The General Assistance Program</u>: Maine Township provides temporary financial assistance to residents with little to no income and/or assets.

<u>Emergency Rent:</u> Maine Township can pay a portion of rent due to residents facing eviction, while the remaining balance is paid by the resident.





<u>Energy Assistance:</u> Maine Township may provide a one-time grant towards utility bills for qualifying families.

**Benefit Access:** Maine Township gives discounts on license plate stickers to low income seniors and disabled individuals.





<u>Public Aid:</u> Maine Township helps residents apply for Medicaid, SNAP (food stamps), and cash assistance.

<u>MaineLines</u>: Maine Township has a transportation program for low income seniors or disabled residents, which provides money for taxi rides to and from Maine Township.





<u>Medicare Assistance:</u> Maine Township has knowledgeable case workers who can help all seniors (no income limits) to navigate Medicare plans.

<u>Food Pantry:</u> The Maine Township Pantry distributes **free food** to qualifying residents.
