DAY 1 Welcome to Massachusetts! Arrive at the Westin Copley Place in Boston for a 2-night stay. Dinner.

DAY 2 Breakfast. Guided tour along the Freedom Trail in Boston. Free time at historic Quincy Market. Guided tour of Lexington & Concord. Dinner.
