

YOUR ITINERARY

DAY 1 Aloha! Arrive in Honolulu with a lei greeting. This city of sunsets, rainbows and tropical flowers sits like a gem between ancient volcanoes and the deep blue sea. Arrive at the Sheraton Waikiki Beach for 4 nights.


