## YOUR ITINERARY

**DAY 1** Travel to Reykjavik, Iceland.

**DAY 2** Welcome to the Land of Fire and Ice! Explore Reykjavik, Iceland’s capital city, blending modern architecture and history. Lunch. Visit landmarks like Hallgrímskirkja Church, Harpa Concert Hall, and the colorful Old Harbor area while learning about Reykjavík’s unique culture and heritage. Arrive at the Fosshotel Reykjavik for a 1-night stay. Dinner.

**DAY 3** Breakfast. Explore the iconic Kirkjufell mountain and surrounding landscapes. Take in the stunning coastal cliffs and wildlife-rich environment of Arnarstapi. Lunch. Discover Ytri Tunga beach, where seals can be spotted in their natural habitat. Arrive at Vesturland Hotel for a 1-night stay. Dinner.

**DAY 4** Breakfast. Journey to Pingvellir National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where the tectonic plates of North America and Eurasia drift apart, making it a geological wonder and a historic landmark as the birthplace of Iceland’s parliament. Witness the impressive eruptions of Strokkur at Geysir Geothermal Area. Lunch. Take in the dramatic Gullfoss waterfall. Arrive at Hotel Selfoss for a 1-night stay. Dinner.

**DAY 5** Breakfast. Visit the famous Seljalandsfoss waterfall and walk behind the water for a unique perspective. Admire the majestic waterfall Skógafoss. Discover the black sand and striking basalt formations at Reynisfjara beach. Lunch. Visit the picturesque village of Vík. Arrive at Fosshotel Nupar for a 2-night stay. Dinner.







**DAY 6** Breakfast. Admire the beauty of glaciers, ice caves, and the famous Svartifoss waterfall at Skaftafell. Lunch. Visit the iconic Jökulsárlón lagoon to witness the floating icebergs and the remarkable scenery. Dinner.

**DAY 7** Breakfast. Visit the breathtaking Fjaðrárgljúfur canyon for stunning views. Lunch. Journey to the Caves of Hella, and discover evidence of Iceland's early settlers. Arrive at Fosshotel Reykjavik for a 1-night stay. Dinner.
