DAY 1 Motorcoach departs from Chicago. Lunch at Fried Green Tomatoes, Galena, IL. Explore the charms of historic Galena. Visit the National Mississippi River Museum & Aquarium in Dubuque, Iowa. Get acquainted with America's major river that has contributed to our nation's colorful history, legend and lore. Arrive at the Hampton Inn, Dubuque, Iowa. Dinner.

DAY 2 Experience the magic of the Mississippi on a 100-mile river cruise aboard the Celebration Belle. Cruise from Dubuque to Moline while enjoying a breakfast, lunch, & prime rib dinner as well as narration by the captain, live entertainment, activities, travel through three locks & dams and views of wildlife and majestic bluffs.
