DAY 1 Welcome to Toronto. Arrive at the Marriott Eaton Centre in downtown Toronto for a 2-night stay. Dinner.

DAY 2 Breakfast. Guided tour of Canada's largest city — Toronto. Narrated harbor cruise of Lake Ontario. Visit the CN Tower, the world's largest free-standing structure. Dinner.

DAY 3 Breakfast. Scenic travel through Canada to Niagara-on-the-Lake, Ontario, known as "the prettiest little town in Canada" with free time for lunch & shopping on Queen Street. Arrive at the lovely Prince of Wales Hotel located in Niagara-on-the-Lake for a 3-night stay. Dinner.

DAY 4 Breakfast. Niagara City Cruises Voyage to the Falls Boat Tour. Explore the first major power plant on the Canadian side of the Niagara River with immersive exhibits, restored artifacts and interactive storytelling. Then descend 180 ft in a glass-paneled elevator to explore the 2,200-foot long tunnel, leading to an observation deck at the river's edge. Dinner. Royal George Theater Shaw Festival performance.

DAY 5 Breakfast. Niagara Gardens, featuring the world's largest floral clock. Visit the Butterfly Conservatory. Ride over the vibrant waters of the Niagara River in a Whirlpool Aero Cars and enjoy the spectacular views of the swirling Niagara Whirlpool. Farewell dinner.
