As you pass through the village, notice well-tended flowers, lush greenery, authentic Bavarian architecture, giving it the name, "Michigan's Little Bavaria." Arrive at the Bavarian Lodge for a 2-night stay. The lodge is nestled on the banks of the beautiful Cass River. German Dinner with all the trimmings at the Bavarian Inn with German entertainment.

DAY 2 Breakfast. A local guide in Bavarian costume showcases Frankenmuth. Learn the art of pretzel making at the Bavarian Inn & discover German wines at the wine tasting.
