Join us for this rare opportunity to meet and talk to a ghost, Mamah, the wife of Frank Lloyd Wright. Mamah returns to our world at the moment of her death, as a ghost, to tell her own story. They both were married to other people and had eight children between them. They flaunted the social mores of their time and abandoned their family obligations. They ran off together to pursue their work, together and separately. They spent time in Europe, then later settled in Wisconsin where Mr. Wright built Taliesin for Mamah. She was expected to behave in a carefully prescribed manner. When she did not, she became an outcast. She lived what was left of her short life as the female head of household at Taliesin, where she was murdered on August 15, 1914.

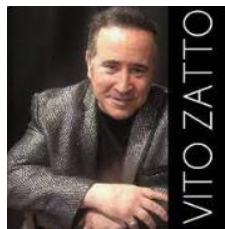

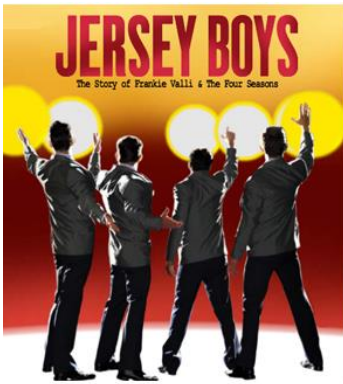

Considered a City of Neighborhoods, Chicago has many immigrant neighborhoods that have fascinating architecture, murals, and parks that reflect their identity. Pilsen is a fascinating community, which has served as a port of entry for many immigrant groups. Our day will begin with a visit to the National Museum of Mexican Art, featuring Mexican, Latino, and Chicago art and culture, followed with lunch. We will finish the day with Julia Bachrach, a Chicago Park District historian, preservation planner, and urban design professional. She will join us on the bus and lead a tour of Pilsen architecture, history and murals. We will learn about the "Bohemian Baroque" architecture of the late 19th century, as well as contemporary murals and other aesthetic contributions of more recent Mexican immigrants.
